Easter Sunday Message Based Curriculum

Opening

- Begin with a **brief welcome** and **prayer** to set the tone for the group time.
- **Introduce the theme:** Hope is found in the reality of the resurrection. The tomb is empty, and Jesus is alive. Let's stop looking for the living among the dead.

Discussion Questions

CONNECT

- 1. What has Easter meant to you this year?
- 2. How did you and/or your family celebrate?

DISCOVER

READ LUKE 24:1-12 ALOUD TOGETHER

- 3. The women came to the tomb with burial spices in hand, expecting to find Jesus still dead and in the grave. What are some ways that our actions show a lack of faith in Jesus and His promises?
- 4. What does the angels' question to the women mean? "Why do you look for the living among the dead?" What is the insinuation about their faith?
- 5. What emotions do you imagine the women felt in verses 1–12? How might those emotions mirror our own experiences with grief, disappointment, or surprise?

READ EPHESIANS 2:4-5 ALOUD TOGETHER

6. What is the significance of this verse for our everyday lives?

REFLECT

- 7. How would you define where you are in life right now?
 - o Hope-filled?
 - Suffering?
 - o The one who feels too far gone?
 - o Skeptical?
- **8.** How does the resurrection speak to each of these? Use this time as a group to encourage one another with the truth of the Gospel.

APPLY

Here are some ways to help you see the Gospel come to life this week:

- Speak the resurrection over your life. Start each morning by reminding yourself:
 - o "The tomb is empty. Jesus is alive. My hope is secure.
- Share with someone this week why the resurrection gives you hope.
- Invite someone into your home or to church who needs to hear about the lifechanging power of the Resurrection.
- Reach out to someone who is suffering and remind them that they're seen and loved by Jesus.

Prayer Time + Closing

- Either break into pairs or smaller groups, or as a group, share and pray for one another.
 - o **Pray for those who need the Hope of Jesus:** Ask everyone to share one name for whom you can pray together.
- Encourage everyone to continue to remember the sacrifice Jesus made for us. Just because Easter is over, the resurrection lasts forever! Let's walk in that together!
